

Women of the United Church Network

The responsibilities of the Women of the United Church Network are:

1. To oversee and co-ordinate UCW activities within Saskatchewan Conference.
2. To find ways to connect with all women in the United Church, in order to share information, give support and provide faith development opportunities:
3. To provide effective communication through:
 - information sharing by committee members
 - statistics and data collection using UCW forms.
4. To provide education and leadership development by:
 - projects and events
 - educational component at committee meetings
 - distribution of resource material
5. To maintain connections with the National Consultation of Women of the United Church.
6. To encourage and support the UCW in outreach activities.
7. To prepare Saskatchewan Conference UCW annual report to the National Consultation.
8. To ensure administration and promotion of the Bursary Fund.

Tasks:

1. To build the network by extending an invitation for all women in the Conference to join the network
2. To network with other groups and gatherings as appropriate
3. To plan for the future and discern other ways that they might network
4. To communicate with the Conference at large about the work of the Network.
5. To connect with the Faith Formation Network around stewardship education information for disbursal within the network communications.
