- Unrestricted funds of less than \$37,500
- Brief description of the project, how it is a "Green Project", and with an explanation of any independent funding
- Quotes and estimates
- Charitable Status printout
- Estimated start date and anticipated implementation schedule

Guidelines for the Green Initiative Grants

Maximum grant amount is \$5,000 matching grant per application, for a six-year period.

Applications will be processed "first come first served" basis, but priorities will be given to first time applicants.

Applications will be received until the grant money runs out for that year

Applicants who are turned down because the grant money had run out will need to reapply in the next calendar year. (The same application form can be resubmitted.)
